Getting There

By Car: WACC is located at <u>255 N. Commerce Park Loop</u> and is about a 10 min drive west from the University of Arizona campus. There is parking available in front of the building.

By Streetcar: For those without cars, WACC can be reached by the <u>Sun Link streetcar</u>. The Sun Link Street car runs between the University of Arizona and the <u>Mercado San Augustin</u> on the west side of I-10. WACC is a short <u>15 minute walk</u> from the last stop at Avenida del Convento and Congress Street.
